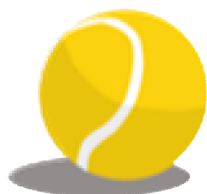

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS AND NOTES

1. Junior Events are open to boys and girls, provided that they are of the required age or under at midnight, 31st January 2012.
2. This Tournament will be conducted in accordance with Tennis Australia's member protection by-law, these rules and regulations and the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (each as amended from time to time).
3. I acknowledge that as a participant in a Tennis Australia sanctioned event I agree to comply with the ITF Rules of Play, the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (including its reference to spectator behavior and interference), the Tennis Australia Member Protection By-law and the Tennis Australia Anti-Doping Policy.
4. Inappropriate spectator behavior could result in denial of entry at future Tennis Australia or Member Association sanctioned events, and will be dealt with in accordance with these policies. This included but is not limited to tennis venues, hotels and transport vehicles.
5. I consent to be involved in any publicity connected with a Tennis Australia Sanctioned Tournament, including media interviews, photographs and TV footage. Please inform the tournament organizer if you do not wish to be involved in publicity.
6. The Diadora Pro Circuit ball will be used exclusively at this tournament.
7. All players must report personally to the venue tournament box upon arrival for your match. Any player not ready when called by the tournament official will forfeit the match.
8. All entrants are to be current registered Playing members of Tennis Victoria or another member association and provide their Registered Player Number.
9. No telephone entries or late entries will be accepted. Entries close midnight on Thursday 12th January.
10. Events will be seeded by Tennis Victoria using the latest Australian Rankings available.
11. Tennis Victoria will appoint the required officials. A referee will be appointed and his or her duties include the right to cancel an event, change the length of matches and issue a formal advice, followed by an Official Warning to a player for behaving in a manner detrimental to the good image of tennis. Should a player continue to offend, on or off the court during the tournament, after such official warning, the Referee may disqualify the player during the match, or from taking any further part in the tournament.
12. The Tournament Director, in consultation with the Referee, reserves the right to reject entries, have event played away from the clubs courts and completed matches under lights.
13. The Glen Iris Valley Recreation Club accepts no liability for injury or loss of property during the tournament.
14. Competitors and tournament officials only will be allowed on courts.
15. The scheduled time of a competitors match will be available online at <http://tournaments.tennis.com.au> and it is a competitor's responsibility to check their own times. You will also find a copy of the schedule at the venue.
16. No refund of entries will be made once the draw has been released. Players are required to supply a medical certificate if withdrawing from the event due to injury.
17. Players must be registered playing members of Tennis Victoria and provide their registration number.
18. There will be qualifying events with a consolation which will be knock out format. Main draw will also have consolation.
19. I consent to Tennis Australia and/or organizers of Tennis Australia Sanctioned Tournaments to use details provided on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournaments, via post, email or SMS.
20. It is recommended for every athlete to be a member of an affiliated tennis club within their state of residency.
21. As an entrant in this event, Tennis Australia recommends that your coach is a Tennis Australia certified coach. This will ensure that the coach has currently updated his/her coaching credentials, has been police checked and has an updates first aid qualification.
22. I acknowledge that all Tennis Australia policies can be readily views at www.tennis.com.au and that it is my responsibility to view these and seek clarification, if required, from Tennis Australia.
23. Players may enter one singles and one doubles event only in the same age group.
